What is labor Day?

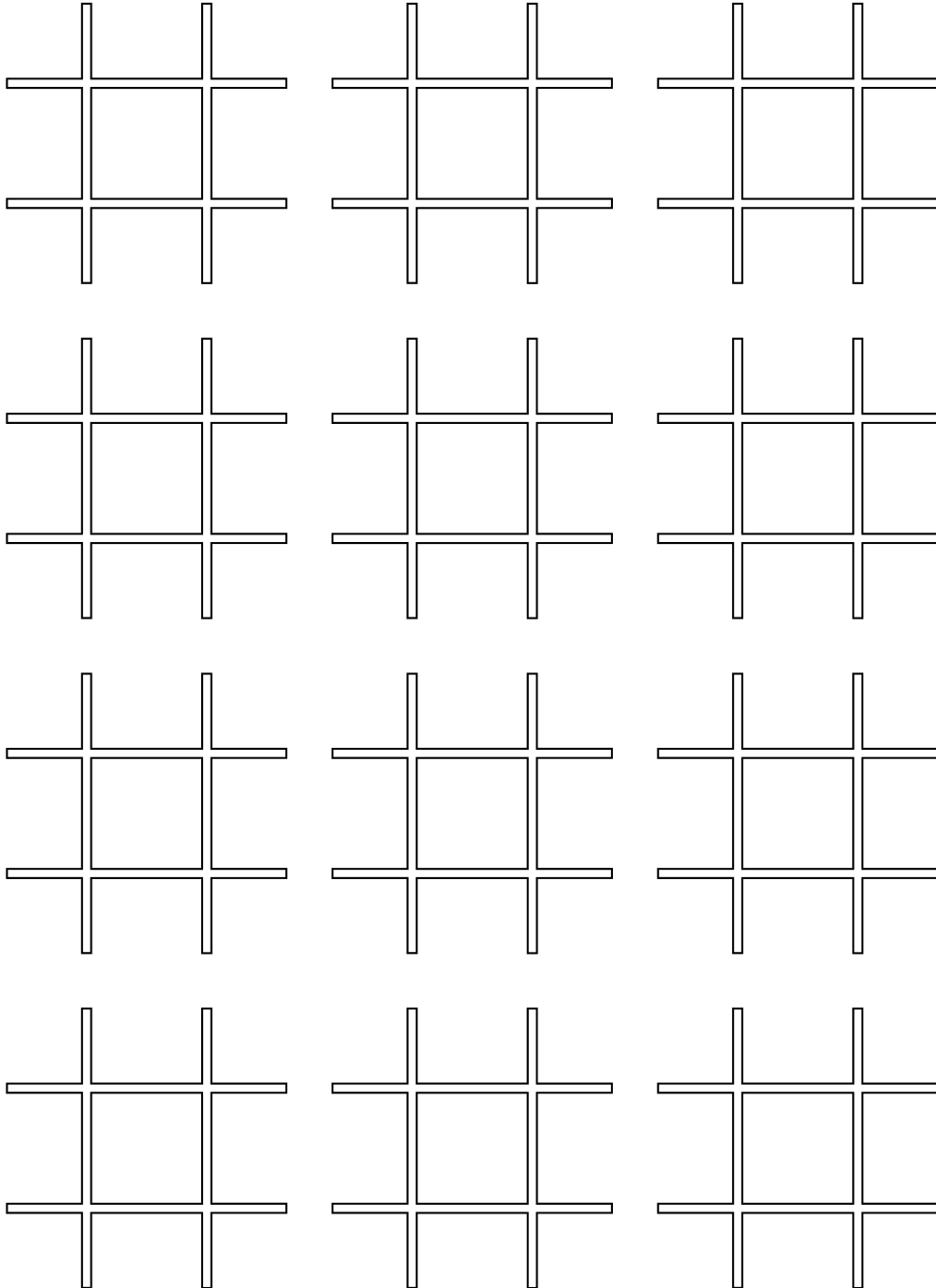
Labor Day is a U.S. holiday celebrated on the first Monday in September to honor and recognize the contributions of workers and the labor movement.

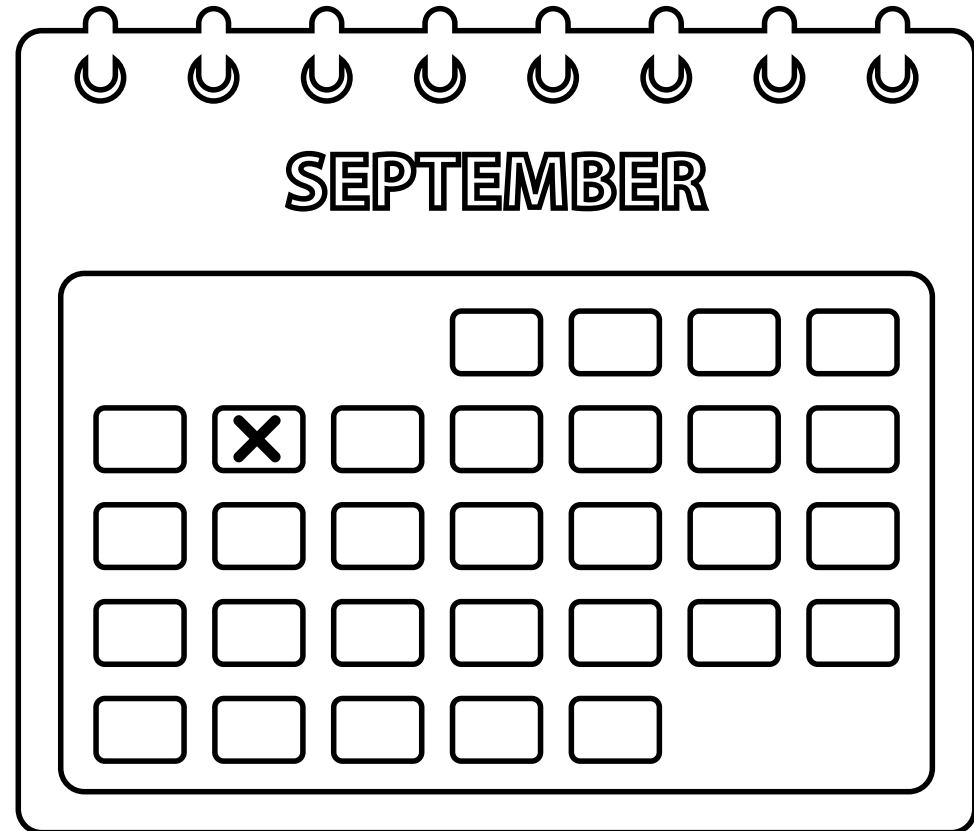


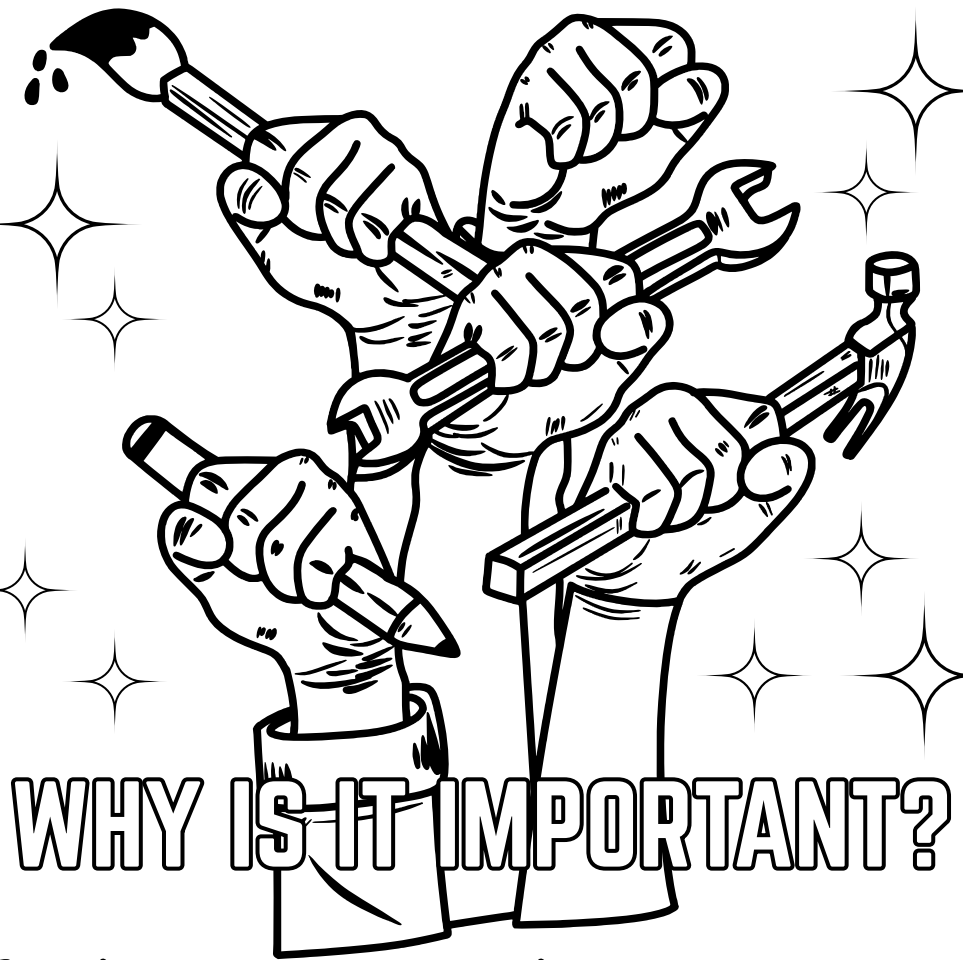

- In many other countries (like the UK, Germany, and India): A similar holiday is celebrated as International Workers' Day on May 1st



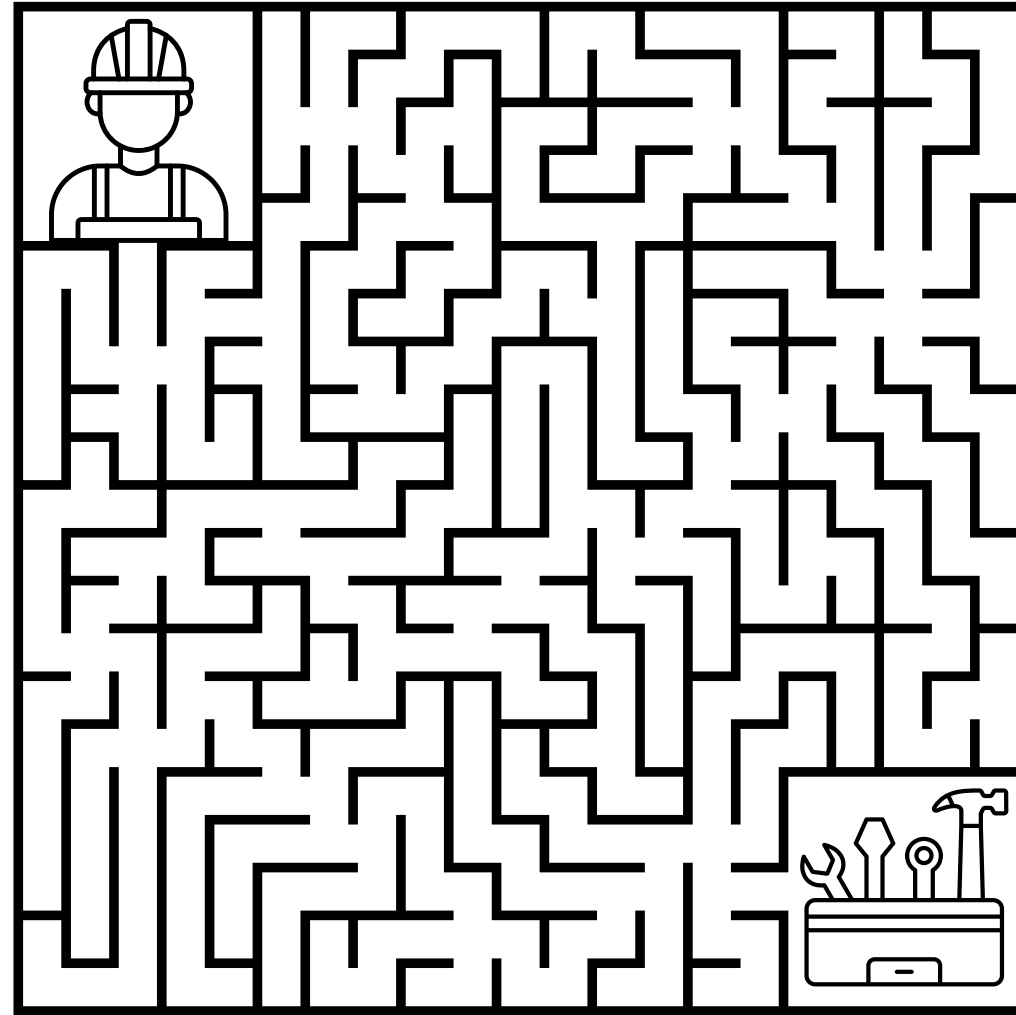


WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

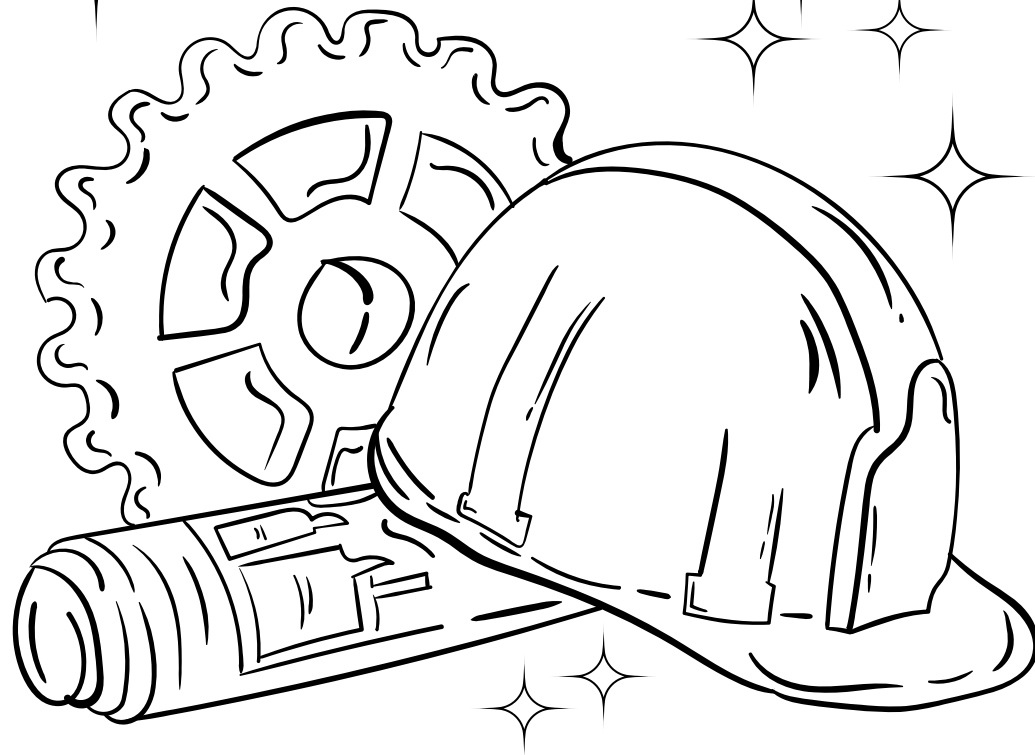

Historical Background

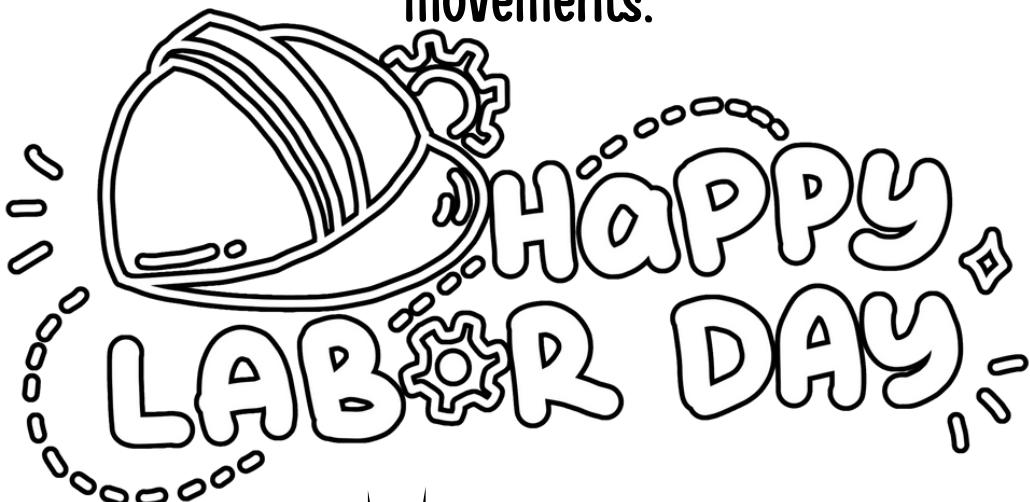
Labor Day began in the late 1800s during the Industrial Revolution, a time when many people worked long hours in unsafe factories for low pay. Workers started organizing unions, holding strikes, and demanding better conditions.



HAYMARKET AFFAIR

(1886)

A major labor protest in Chicago that turned violent. Though not directly tied to the holiday, it influenced global labor rights movements.



PULLMAN STRIKE

(1894)

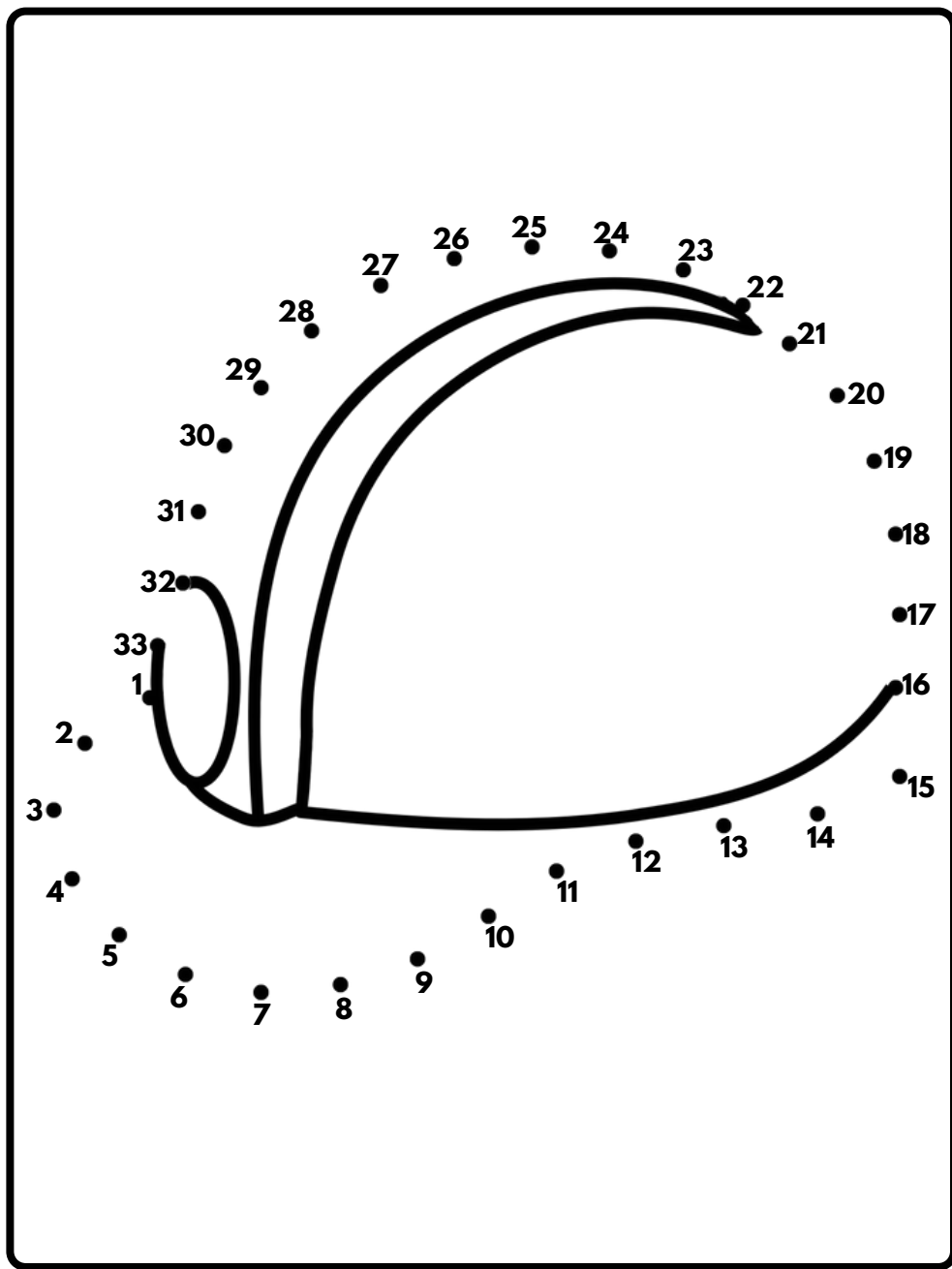
A national railway strike that led to riots. In response, President Grover Cleveland declared Labor Day a national holiday to appease workers.
